



# Lesson Plan

Topic: Where is the post office?

Subject: English Language

Level: Primary 5 (24 students) Duration: 60 minutes

## Leaching objectives:

Upon completion of the lesson, students should be able to:

Describe the locations of places on the street maps or pictures clearly using the correct prepositions of places (i.e., between, in front of, across from, behind, on, next to) and names of places (i.e., police station, park, bank, restaurant, street, hospital, pay phone, hotel and post office)

## Language skills:

Speaking:

> Students could produce utterances using the prepositions and names of places.

## Students' prior knowledge:

Students have learnt the vocabulary regarding the names of places on the street (i.e., post office, police station, hotel, restaurant, bank, hospital, pay phone, park, etc.), and the pattern of a question using the wh-word 'where'.

<ul> <li>While-task 1: Language Practice</li> <li>To acquaint students with how to describe the location through group working on a topic-based task</li> <li>(From the Essential of Language Teaching, 2003-2007, A project of the National Capital Language Center)</li> <li>Time: 8 mins</li> </ul>	<ol> <li>Teacher divides students into groups of four, with mixed abilities and gender.</li> <li>Teacher provides a clear step-by- step explanation to students on how to do the task.         <ol> <li>Each group reads the assigned passage and circle the important cues in the passage that they think are useful to illustrate a location.</li> <li>Every group member work cooperatively by drawing a simple map based on the information they get from the assigned passage.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>	<ul> <li>Six passages on the theme of describing how to get somewhere (Refer to Appendix VI)</li> <li>Passages 1: There is a zoo in my neighborhood. 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<ul> <li>While-task 2: Speaking Practice</li> <li>To provides chances for students to produce verbal outputs by describing the locations using the names and prepositions of place</li> <li>Time: 12-15 mins</li> </ul>	<ol> <li>Teacher invites each group to make a 2-minute presentation based on the map drawn.</li> <li>Teacher provides constructive feedback based on students' performance of the group task.</li> <li>Teacher shows students the suggested answers (i.e. the possible maps) regarding the six short passages and recapitulates the appropriate use of names and prepositions of place when describing the locations.</li> </ol>	➢ Map drawn by students
<ul> <li>While-task 3: Consolidation</li> <li>To consolidate students' understanding of the prepositions of place</li> <li>Time: 5 mins</li> </ul>	<ol> <li>Teacher reviews the knowledge of prepositions of place by asking students to do the fill-in-the-blank worksheets.</li> <li>Teacher checks the answers and summarizes the content with students.</li> </ol>	<ul> <li>A PowerPoint slide showing the fill-in-the-blank worksheet (Refer to Appendix VII)</li> <li>Exercise</li> <li>Exercise</li> <li>1. 




