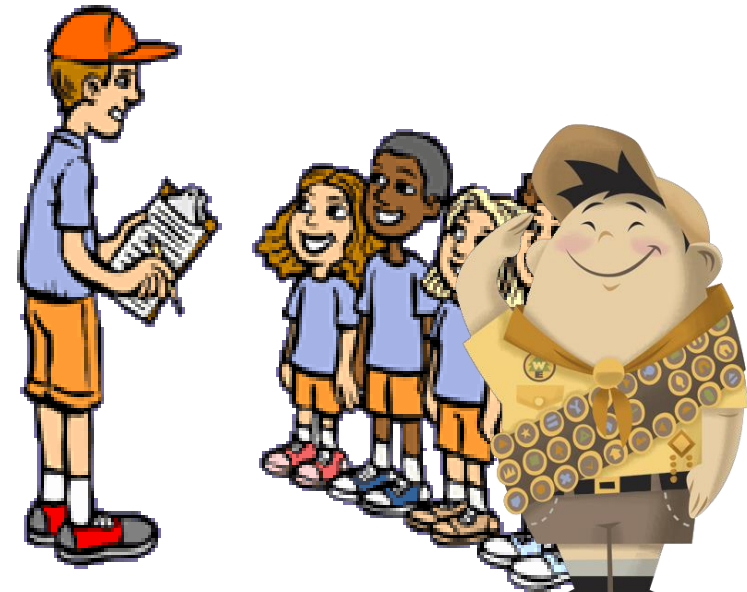
# Adjective groups

- We felt tired.



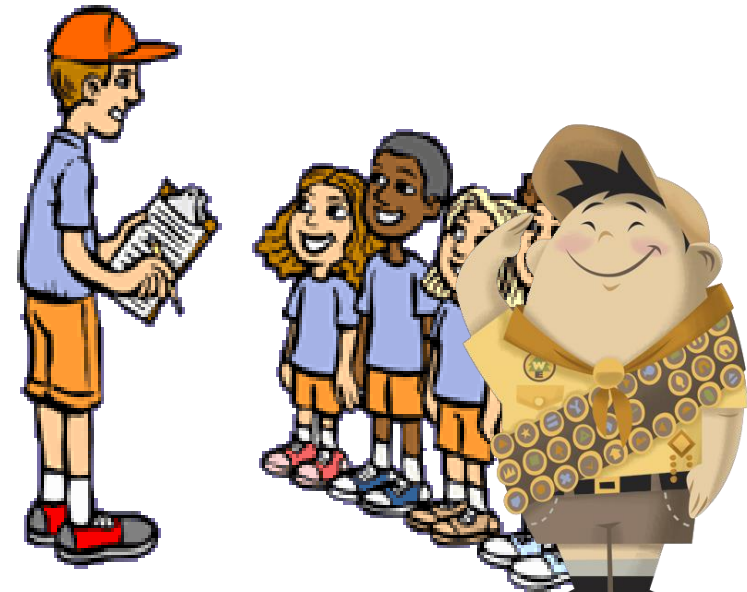

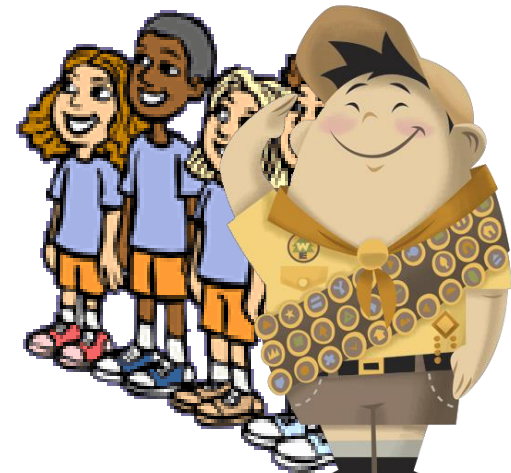

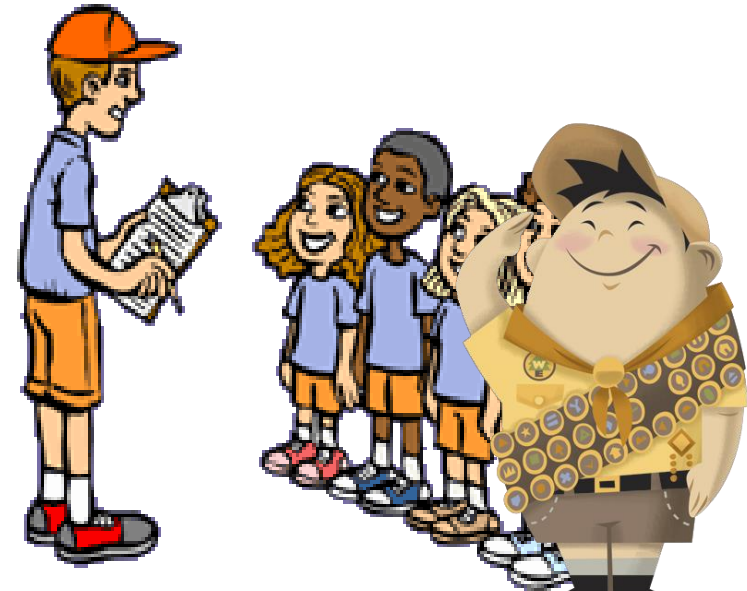

# Time expressions

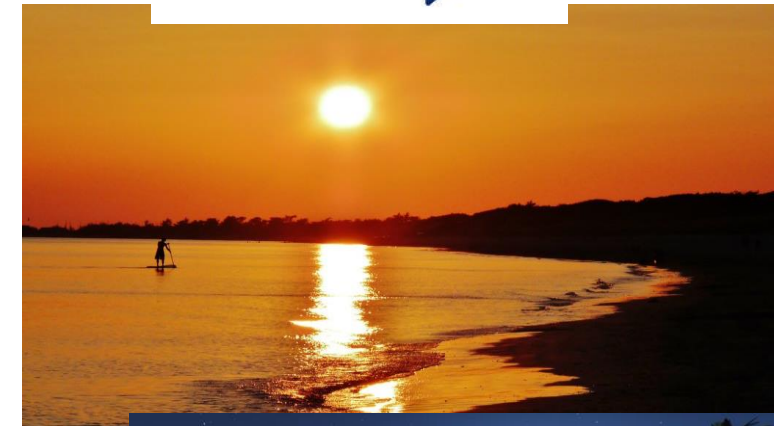
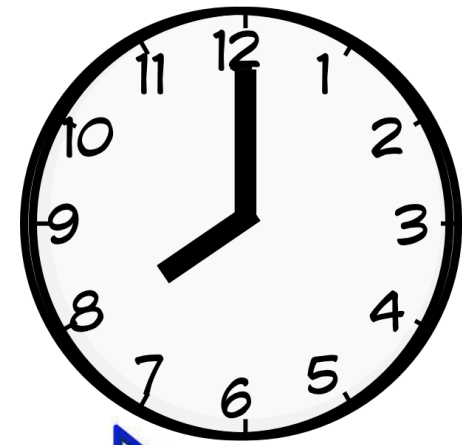
We usually describe events according to the time sequence in recount.

**Next**, we got into groups to put up our tents.

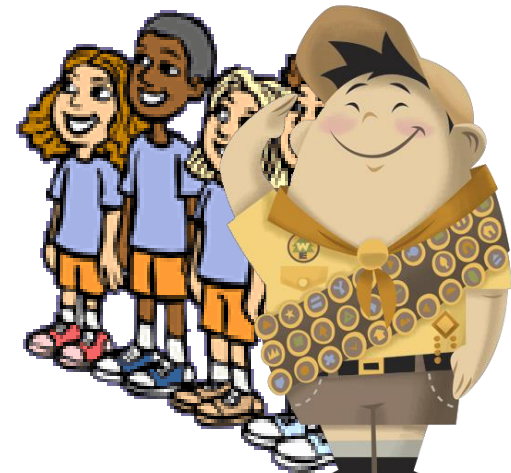

or at the end of sentence!

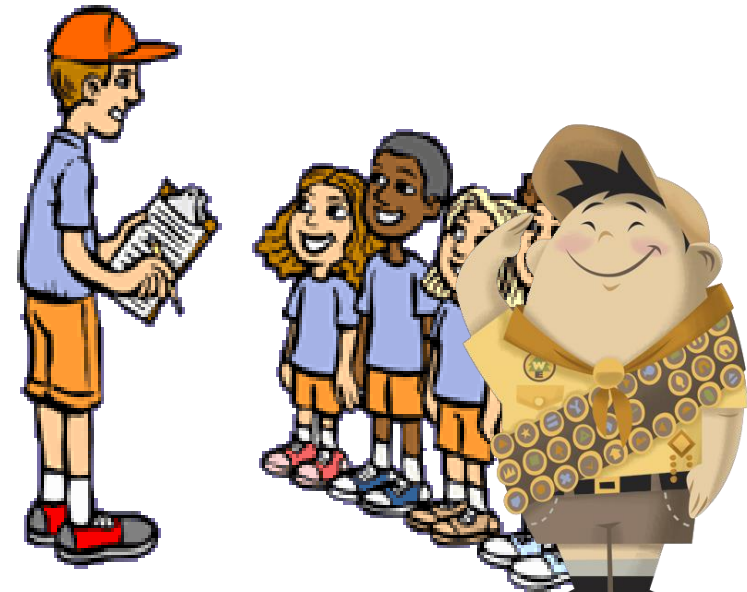
